

# Hebrew Calendar

These are the post-exilic names of the months. To keep this lunar calendar properly synchronized to the seasons with 30-day months, occasionally an additional 6th (Eiul) or 12th (Adar) month was added. Only 4 of the original names of the months are recorded in Scripture: "Abib" for Nisan, "Ziv" for Iyyar, "Ethanim" for Tishri, and "Bul" for Marchesvan.
