Isaiah 60 (selected verses)

Arise, shine; for you light has come, and the glory of the LORD has risen upon you.

For behold, darkness will cover the earth and deep darkness the peoples; but the LORD will rise upon you and His glory will appear upon you.

Nation will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.
