

## Genesis 22:1-19 • The Shadow of the Cross

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1. (v.1-3) What takes place between Abraham and Isaac and replayed between the Father and the Son is found in the repeated phrase, “ \_\_\_\_\_ ”.
2. (v.4-8) It takes place on the \_\_\_\_\_ day with the son bearing the \_\_\_\_\_ to the hill for his own \_\_\_\_\_.
3. (v.9-14) Isaac prefigures \_\_\_\_\_ by going from death to life, but prefigures each of \_\_\_\_\_ in that God provides a personal \_\_\_\_\_ in our \_\_\_\_\_.
4. (v.15-19) The promises to Abraham for his \_\_\_\_\_ prefigure the promises to come through \_\_\_\_\_ for His obedience.
