

Leviticus 23 • The Lord's Appointed Times

1. (v.1-2) God calls His people to be set apart to Him exclusively.
2. (v.3) It's not about being obedient just when and where others can observe us, but truly from the heart in whatever place we happen to be.
3. (v.4-8) First the blood of the Lamb, then the putting away of sin.
4. (v.9-14) The whole harvest—both literal and spiritual—belongs to the Lord.
5. (v.15-21) The bread that would come from the grain illustrated how believers would be united in Christ through the Spirit at Pentecost.
6. (v.22) A right relationship with God requires a right relationship with others, even during the Lord's appointed times.
7. (v.23-25) Whereas the first set of feasts represent the work of the Messiah at His First Coming, the second set of feasts represent the work of the Messiah at His Second Coming.
8. (v.26-32) The Messiah returns for those who have returned to Him in sincerity and repentance from the heart.
9. (v.33-44) The Feast of Booths represents the establishment of the Millennial Kingdom.
