

Deuteronomy 7 • Dealing with the Enemy

1. (v.1-2) We are not to enter into any kind of relationship with adherents of cults or other religions.
2. (v.3-5) We are not to enter into personal relationships with members of cults or other religions.
3. (v.6-8) We are called by God to be separate from the world.
4. (v.9-11) To successfully separate from the enemy and fulfill God's calling is accomplished by obedience to His Word.
5. (v.12-16) Sometimes persecution comes because of evil in the world, and sometimes because of believers' disobedience.
6. (v.17-21) We're not supposed to be satisfied with the status quo but with completely overcoming and removing false spiritual influences.
7. (v.22-26) It really comes down to a spiritual battle for the heart, mind and soul. (2 Cor. 7:1; Rom. 13:14)
