Read and compare:

1. (v.1-8) The corruption of <u>personal</u> relationships reflected a growing <u>spiritual</u> corruption, both of which occurred from the <u>heart</u>.

2. (v.9-13) Not merely temporarily <u>fallen</u>, he no longer <u>trusted</u>
God and began seeking <u>help</u> from another source in His place.

Overall: It occurred by slow <u>degrees</u>. First it was tolerated in his <u>household</u>, then he became <u>comfortable</u> with it, and eventually he openly practiced <u>idolatry</u>. Ultimately he <u>forgot</u> the Lord and to serve idols.
