

1 Chronicles 28-29:22 • Spiritual Legacies

1. (v.1) The number one priority is to ensure that normal worship activities continue uninterrupted.
2. (v.2-7) The things of God are worthless if not founded on and maintained in accordance with the Word of God.
3. (v.8) The things of God are useful only if one's life is committed to the right things to begin with.
4. (v.9-11, 19) The things of God come about because of God's will, not man's.
5. (v.20-29:1) Special projects are actually supposed to be carried out in the same way as "normal" church activities, each person contributing according to their gifts and calling.
6. (v.2-5) Contributions to God's work are supposed to be accepted only from those with a right heart. It's an act of worship.
7. (v.6-9) You don't join to get something in return; you join out of joy from an obedient heart.
8. (v.10-16) It really comes down to what kind of steward you are with what God has entrusted to you.
9. (v.17-19) The true rewards of good stewardship are not material, but spiritual.
10. (v.20-22) The right approach to special projects is exactly the same as any normal gathering of Believers: worship.
