

2 Chronicles 18-19:3 • Making Unholy Alliances

Part One: How Alliances Are Made

1. (v.1-3) We allow feelings or relationships to supersede God's Word to the contrary
 - a. We allow a single, common issue to become more important than all the other differences.
 - b. It always sounds spiritual, noble, and right.
2. False alliances are built on spiritual seduction.
3. (v.4-13) Satan tries to overwhelm the one true messenger with hundreds of false messengers.
4. False messengers tell you what you want to hear; true messengers tell you what you need to hear.
5. The core issue is really God's Word and the effort to suppress it.

Part Two: God's Phases of Judgment

1. Phase 1: God ceases to correct.
2. Phase 2: God removes real leadership.
3. Phase 3: God sends a delusion. (2 Th. 2:11-12)
4. Anyone who doesn't love the truth of God's Word does not love Jesus.
(Jn. 14:15)

Part Three: False Believers' True Agenda

1. Step 1: Gain credibility and protection they can never get on their own.
2. Step 2: Establish a fall guy for their agenda.
3. Step 3: Make someone else the target.

Part Four: God's Work with Believers in Such Situations

1. (19:1-3) Nothing short of God's intervention will save.
 - a. You might escape with your life, but there will be no victory.
2. (20:35-37) Not learning and repeating this mistake will lead to experiencing God's judgment and personal loss.
3. God provides protection from the outset through His Word. We experience the consequences of rejecting His Word for feelings and relationships that seem or feel right instead.
