## 2 Chronicles 24 • The Rise and Fall of King Joash

1.	(v.1-3) Although sincere, it was not a <u>life-long</u> commitment.
2.	(v.4-14) For a time there was a right return to the things and resources of God.
3.	(v.17-22) Things began to go wrong when the wrong <u>influences</u> were allowed to take control.
4.	(v.23-25) Ultimately it led to <u>forsaking</u> the Lord completely which always gives way to God's <u>judgment</u> .
