

2 Chronicles 30 • Returning to the Blood of the Lamb

1. (v.1-4) The invitation is for everyone.
2. (v.5-9) The invitation addresses the issues of pride, sin, and unfaithfulness.
3. (v.10-12) The invitation will not be welcomed by everyone.
4. (v.13-15a) It's not a one-time calling, but a permanent calling away from sin.
5. (v.15b-20) It's begins with the blood of the Lamb.
 - a. 1 Samuel 15:22
 - b. Psalm 51:16-17
6. (v.21-31:1) It results in a changed life not just AT church but AWAY from church. Finally rid of sin, they seek to sin no more.
 - It takes place from the heart.
 - It always involved a return to the blood of the Lamb.
 - It's followed through with a commitment to God's Word and ways.
 - It results in a permanently changed lifestyle.
