Esther 2 • Doing It God's Way

- 1. The one who <u>pleases</u> the King is the one who God is going to use.
- 2. No one comes to the Father unless they're <u>drawn</u> or <u>called</u> He will get us into the <u>right position</u> to fulfill His will.
- 3. If we **DON'T** do the things God has for us to do, He's going to get someone else to do it.
- 4. A big part of the process of getting us in the right place is discipleship and the leading of the Holy Spirit.
- 5. Before the Lord will bring a true Christian to a place of real power, He will anoint that person for burial. This is called the "Season of Myrrh".
- 6. Deut. 8:2-3, 16-18. God's blessing is always preceded by a <u>death</u> to self.
- 2 Cor. 11:28-33; Gal. 6:17. Like Jesus, Paul was <u>anointed</u> for great things in the kingdom because he was <u>anointed</u> for burial. It ALL has to go to <u>the cross</u>.
- 8. Mat. 13:3-8. The "Season of Myrrh" is generally the most difficult for new believers, but the "Season of Spice" is the most difficult for mature believers.
 - a. We have our choice of anything, but must choose only according to the direction of the Holy Spirit.
- 9. 1 Pe. 3:18-22. Peter uses the example of Noah from the perspective of <u>unsaved</u> people and the "Season of Myrrh".
- 10. Mat. 24:37-39. Jesus uses the example of Noah from the perspective of saved people and the "Season of Spice".
