

Job 3 • When Silence Comes to an End

1. (v.1-10) Rather than **curse** God, as Satan predicted and Job's wife advocated, Job deflects it to **curse** the day of his birth.

2. (v.11-19) **Death** is the great equalizer for everyone regardless of their **station** in this life.

3. (v.20-26) For believers, the most difficult thing to overcome when experiencing **suffering** is reconciling it with what we personally know about **God**, His **Word**, and His **ways**.

Overall Application:

From the outset, Job's question is about God's **will**, not about relief from **sin**.
