

Job 28 • The Pursuit for What Matters

1. (v.1-11) Man goes to great lengths and efforts to uncover **physical** things that are hidden and buried in **darkness**, bringing them out into the **light** of his world for his use. This is an allusion to the **spiritual**.
2. (v.12-22) Even the most valuable earthly commodities cannot purchase something that can only be obtained by **obedience** to God's **Word**. It does not exist in any form that man can obtain by his own **will** and **effort**.
3. (v.23-28) What matters most is **fear** (extreme **regard** for) of the **Lord** and **willful** separation from **sin**.
