

## Job 36:1-16 • The Working of God's Righteousness

---

1. (v.1-5) Biblical **love** does not exist in the absence of **righteousness**—the application of God's **truth**.
2. (v.6-7) There are no promises of remedies for the **ills** of this **life**. The guarantee is for the final, **eternal** outcome, not necessarily for the present, **temporary** situation.
3. (v.8-10) Whereas unrighteousness is actually the condition of being **enslaved** to things of this world, God's righteousness is actually a choice in, and expression of, spiritual **freedom**. (Rom. 6:17-19)
4. (v.11-14) Righteousness comes about through one's recognition of the **bonds** holding them and turning to **God** for **release**; the godless never turn to **God**.
5. (v.15-16) The righteous are not exempt from **affliction**, but are listening to God—evidenced by their **obedience** to His Word—so that they are led to a place of God's **strength** and **sustenance**.
