

Job 42 • God is Always in Control

1. (v.1-6) Man has neither the understanding nor the power to hold God **accountable** for His **actions**—even suffering. Spiritual things are taking place outside of our **knowledge** for which we have to **trust** God.

2. (v.7-17) God does not condemn for asking **why**, only those who presume to **speak** for **Him**.

The Greatest Lesson of Job:

In Job God allowed an **innocent** man to suffer for His purposes in the course of dealing with **evil (Satan)**; it foreshadows when God will allow the most **innocent** man of all to suffer and die on the **cross** in the ultimate confrontation with **evil (Satan)**.
