

Psalm 40 • Making the Lord Your Trust

1. (v.1-3) One of the proofs of the existence of trust is patience.
2. (v.4-5) What we trust in is a reflection of our commitment to the truth.
3. (v.6-8) it's not a trust in things, but in the truth from the heart.
4. (v.9-10) Proper biblical personal trust eventually reveals itself as a testimony to others.
5. (v.11-12) Biblical trust can be patient because it relies on grace and truth to overcome personal shortcomings.
6. (v.13-17) Trust is not a question of IF God will respond, but WHEN.
