## Ecclesiastes 9 • Extracting the Good from Life

- 1. (v.1) There's a big difference between not knowing what life will bring without <u>trust</u> in God and not knowing what life will bring yet <u>trusting</u> in Him.
- 2. (v.2-6) The only advantage the pursuits of **this** life can bring is if they are rendered in **concert** with God's **will** and **ways** leading to the rewards of the **next** life.
- 3. (v.7-10) The rewards for this life are to enjoy in <u>moderation</u> what is attained in the course of our successful efforts to maintain a right <u>relationship</u> with God.
- 4. (v.11-12) Nothing occurs as the result of our personal <u>strength</u> or <u>will</u> because "time and chance" are controlled by <u>God</u> to produce <u>His</u> desired outcome.
- 5. (v.13-18) Often there is great attentiveness to God in times of extreme <u>stress</u> or <u>persecution</u>, but a tendency to wander away during times of relative <u>peace</u> and <u>blessing</u>.
- 6. The Parable of the Minas (Lk. 19:11-27)
  - a. It's not "how much" we've been given, but what we do with whatever we've been given.
  - b. Not doing anything is a form of rebellion.
  - c. What each individual does is their own <u>choice</u>, but they will be held <u>accountable</u> both in this life and the one to come.
