

## Isaiah 25 • Living Today for Tomorrow

---

1. (v.1-5) It begins by seeing God's promised future as already **fulfilled** because of His past promises already **fulfilled**.
  
2. (v.6-8) In the promised life to come:
  - a. He will "prepare a lavish **banquet**". (v.6)
  
  - b. He will "swallow up the **covering**...over all peoples" (v.7)
  
  - c. He will "swallow up **death** for all time". (v.8)
  
  - d. He will "wipe **tears** away from all faces". (v.8)
  
  - e. He will "remove the **reproach** of His people". (v.8)
  
3. (v.9-12) In the end, those who will be able to **rejoice** will be those who have **endured** and **obeyed** while living out the belief of His actual **return**.
