## Jeremiah 17:1-14 • The Deceitful Heart

1.	(v.1-4) The problem is not occasional <u>backsliding</u> into sin, but a lifestyle of <u>idolatry</u> —choosing something in place of <u>God</u> .
2.	(v.5-8) One living "like a <u>bush</u> in the desert" is one "who trusts in <u>mankind</u> "; One who is "like a <u>tree</u> planted by water" is one "who trusts the <u>LORD</u> ".
3.	(v.9-11) Anything the world has to offer in order to change the <a href="heart">heart</a> will fall short; only Holy-Spirit filled change takes place when the <a href="Word of God">Word of God</a> is taken by <a href="faith">faith</a> .
4.	(v.12-14) Only if we face our sins and return to the Lord is there the <a href="hope">hope</a> —the <a href="hope">assurance</a> , of being healed and saved both in this <a href="life">life</a> and the <a href="one-to-come">one-to-come</a> .
