Jeremiah 42-44 • Seeking God's Counsel

- 1. (42:1-6) They not only want to know what God wants them to do, but how they should walk.
- 2. (42:7-8) God's answer is framed according to their personal choice.
- 3. (42:19-22) Jeremiah's observation is they have <u>never</u> previously made the right <u>choice</u>.
- 4. (43:1-7) As with the history of all their previous **choices**, they follow what goes along with their own **feelings** and **opinions**. This is known as "**self-deception**".
- (44:11-19) The root of their "<u>self-deception</u>" was their assumption that <u>prosperity</u> and <u>abundance</u> is the sign of a right relationship with God instead of a right <u>heart</u> in spite of the circumstances.
- Overall: (1 Sam. 15:22; Rom. 12:1-2) There is no substitute for obedience, without which it is impossible to know and follow God's will.
