Lamentations 1 • When Recognition Finally Comes

- (v.1-2) A <u>relationship</u> with the world which is allowed to supplant a biblical <u>relationship</u> with God results in <u>judgment</u> from God designed to precisely <u>expose</u> the truth of that behavior.
- 2. (v.3-5) <u>Rebellion</u> to our covenant relationship with the Lord reverses one's <u>position</u> compared to the world's and invokes a profound response of <u>mourning</u> on the part of the Lord.
- (v.6-10) Just as <u>adulterous</u> behavior renders the <u>marriage</u> relationship both legally and spiritually empty and without credibility, so <u>unfaithfulness</u> renders the same in our <u>ministry</u> and <u>testimony</u> where our Christianity is concerned.
- (v.13-15) God brings about true <u>recognition</u> of how He has been <u>working</u> on every internal and external level to see one's true spiritual <u>condition</u>.
- 5. (v.16-17) God brings about <u>personal</u> recognition that there is no viable alternative except <u>Him</u> alone.
- 6. (v.18-20) There is finally recognition not just of the spiritual superiority and authority of the Lord, but the real behavior of rebellion to His Word which is the true root cause of everything that has been subsequently experienced.
- 7. (v.21-22) The only cure for disobedience is <u>obedience</u>; the only cure for unfaithfulness is <u>faithfulness</u>.
