## Mark 9 • Opening the Apostles' Eyes

- 1. (v.2-13) Peter <u>saw</u> but was spiritually <u>blind</u>. Lack of faith leads to the <u>misinterpretation</u> of <u>events</u> relating God's Word.
- (v.14-29) The apostles <u>spoke</u> but were spiritually <u>mute</u>. Lack of faith leads to <u>ineffectiveness</u> for those who cease from being <u>doers</u> of God's Word.
- 3. (v.30-32) The apostles <u>heard</u> but did not spiritually <u>understand</u>. Lack of faith is often the result when one expects God's Word to be <u>fulfilled</u> according to one's own <u>expectations</u>.
  - a. (v.30-32) Loving sinners.
  - b. (v.33-37) Loving one another.
  - c. (v.38-41) Loving those <u>outside our immediate</u> fellowship.
  - d. (v.42-50) Loving the lost.
- 4. Summary: Before the <u>Second</u> Coming, there is always the work of the <u>First</u> Coming. Before the work of the Millennial Reign, there is always the work of the <u>cross</u>. Preaching the Gospel and loving others is actually the fulfillment of <u>our work</u> for the Second Coming.
