

Luke 5 • Different Responses to Christ

1. (v.1-11) In the case of those like these disciples, It is not enough to be “**familiar**” with Christ; it requires forever **forsaking** the old life to **follow** Him exclusively.
2. (v.12-14) In the case of those like this leper, salvation produced an **immediate** change empowering the **immediate** spread of the Gospel.
3. (v.17-26) In the case of those like the scribes and Pharisees, they fall short of actually **accepting** Christ because they refuse to recognize themselves as **sinners**.
4. (v.27-28) In the case of those like the Levi, it requires **taking** Jesus at His **word**.
5. (v.29-32) To minister like Christ means to “*call...sinners to **repentance***”.
6. (v.36-39) To minister like Christ means to be a **new creation** who ministers as a **new creation**.
