## 2 Cor. 3:17-18 & 4 • Irrefutable Proof of God's Existence

- (3:17-18) Believers are a visible <u>witness</u> of God's glory and power and <u>freedom</u> in Christ.
- 2. (4:1-2) Believers' "ministry" (literally "service") is intended to reconcile both Believer and non-believer alike.
- 3. (4:3-6) The more a Believer become the image of <u>Christ</u>, the greater their understanding and knowledge of <u>Christ</u>, and the better others see <u>Christ</u> through them.
- 4. (4:7-10) Believers are a visible witness of the power of the resurrection transforming them into the image of Christ as they forsake the old and embrace the new.
- 5. (4:11-12) As Believers are "being made a <u>corpse</u>" to the world, they shine as tangible proof of the existence of God.
- 6. (4:13-15) Believers are supposed to be visible proof of the work of the **resurrection**.
- 7. (4:16-18) When Believers <u>recognize</u> that Christ's death and resurrection works through them a ministry of reconciliation to God, they can live <u>victoriously</u> because they see the spiritual results the world cannot.
