

## Galatians 3 • The Law & Grace, Part I

---

1. (v.1-5) The **personal** argument: The proof of salvation by grace and not the Law is proved by the **personal** salvation **experience** itself.
  
2. (v.6-14) The **scriptural** argument: No one has ever been **saved** by doing the Law because no one can fully **obey** the Law as proven by the **Old Testament** itself.
  
3. (v.15-18) The **logical** argument: The **Mosaic Law** cannot cancel out God's covenant with Abraham. **Promise** and faith go together, never **promise** and the Law.
  - a. (v.19-20) The Law was temporary and intended only for **Israel**.
  - b. (v.21-22) The Law reveals our desperate need for God's **grace**.
  - c. (v.23-29) The Law was provided temporarily until its **fulfillment** in Christ.
