James 2:14-26 • Faith & Works

- 1. (v.14) Belief is only the first step toward having "faith".
- 2. (v.15-17 & 18) The test of faith that is <u>alive</u> is our actions of <u>love</u> for others.
- 3. (v.19) Positions, policies and belief systems do not constitute "faith".
- 4. (v.20) At some point every Christian must face the issue that "faith without works is useless".
- 5. (v.21-25) Faith "perfected" is friendship with God resulting from putting obedience into action.
- 6. (v.26) No matter how hard we "believe" with our heart and soul and mind, "faith" is not achieved without taking action and becoming involved. And no matter how involved and action-oriented we are, our works are useless without the acknowledgment of our heart and soul and mind of Christ for Whom they're accomplished.
